OpenAccess Overview





What is "OA"?

- OpenAccess is a C++ Application Program Interface (API) to an industry standard, enterprise, database for the EDA Industry.
 - "OA" = OpenAccess, as defined by the OpenAccess Coalition
 - API = The Interface between the Application Program an EDA developer creates and the design database
 - Enterprise database = A database intended for multiple simultaneous users and very large amounts of design data
 - EDA = Electronic Design Automation

How do Members use "OA"?

Can be used as a common database for multiple EDA supplier tools within a single design flow

- Cadence, Mentor, Synopsys, Keysight, and others
- This idea is called "Interoperability"

OpenAccess is used by EDA developers

- Several design tools are "native" on OpenAccess
- Several design tools incorporate OpenAccess for data translation
- Proprietary R & D tools that don't yet exist

Used by designers

- C++ for faster tools dealing with huge data (wafer level)
- Scripting form for point tools, quick applications, etc.

Used as a stand-alone database

- Designs can be done end-to-end with only OpenAccess data



Where did OA Come from?

1988: CFI (CAD Framework Initiative)

- Drive Interoperability within the EDA industry
- 1997: CFI became Silicon Integration Initiative in
- 2002: OpenAccess was contributed by Cadence

OpenAccess Coalition formed

OAC Board (Director-Level Members) OA Change Team Two Architects, Cadence and one other Director level Member companies vote

OA Extensions Steering Group Defines Formal Extensions to OpenAccess oaScript, oaxPop, oatDebug,...

Today we have 42 44 member companies
